## GUEST SPEAKER

The Rev. Dean Pierce, Chaplain of the Brethren Care facility of Ashland will be our guest speaker on **Sunday June 2nd**. Dean began his Pastoral ministry in 1986 with the Wesleyan Church and was ordained in 1990. He has served in both the Greater Ohio and Illinois districts. He did his undergrad work at Mt. Vernon Nazarene University and his graduate work at Ashland Theological Seminary. Dean served at Burt Avenue Wesleyan Church in Coshoc-ton, Ohio, helped establish Bridge Builders Divorce Recovery for the county and served at DeKalb Wesleyan Church in DeKalb, IL. He helped establish Moses Basket Diaper Ministry and helped transition two mono-ethnic congregations into a multi-ethnic ministry known as Real Connection Church. At the present time he is the Campus Chaplain for the Brethren Care Village Community here in Ashland. Dean and his wife Rachel have three children and three grandchildren.
